The Historic Garage and House

The famed HP Garage and house situated in [Silicon Valley](#), the very place where Hewlett Packard was founded 70 years ago, has now been listed on the National register of Historic Places by the National Park Service.

This garage was the building in which Bill Hewlett and Dave Packard [set up shop](#) way back in 1938. A year later in 1939, Hewlett-Packard was founded, and a year later, the company outgrew this very site and had to move on to bigger grounds.

African Unity Faces a Test

The Costs of Chasing Ivory Coast's Leader

In a continent where wars and civil wars are far from uncommon, one thing makes the standoff over Ivory Coast's exiled leader all the more puzzling to Africa and around the globe: Laurent Gbagbo, the strongest leader most go.

In the months since Mr. Gbagbo led a long-delayed presidential election, the United Nations, the European Union, the United States, the African Union and the West African regional grouping known as ECOWAS — in a variety of African and international settings — have all declared that he must step down, slapping a near daily array of resolutions on his government until he does so. West African nations have even threatened to use military force to oust him if he refuses to leave.

But Mr. Gbagbo has been adamant, rebuffing a string of African leaders who say he risks losing support this week. That resistance has caused the Ivory Coast to be a divided case of law — and maybe whether — the international community can pressure him to leave who might still support him without any attraction and whose to

DISAPPEARANCES TIED TO PAKISTAN ARE WORRY TO U.S.

NEW TENSION FOR ALLIES

Accounts of Roundups Are Cited in a Report Sent to Congress

WASHINGTON — The Obama administration is expressing alarm over reports that thousands of political opponents and captured Taliban insurgents have disappeared into the hands of Pakistani police and intelligence forces, and that some may have been tortured or killed.

The issue came up in a State Department report to Congress last month that urged Pakistan to address this and other human rights abuses. It threatens to become the latest source of friction in the often tense relationship between the nations allies.

The concern is over a steady stream of accounts from human rights groups that Pakistan's security services have rounded up thousands of people over the past decade, mainly in Baluchistan, a rest and military province far from the light with the Taliban, and are holding them incommunicado without charges. 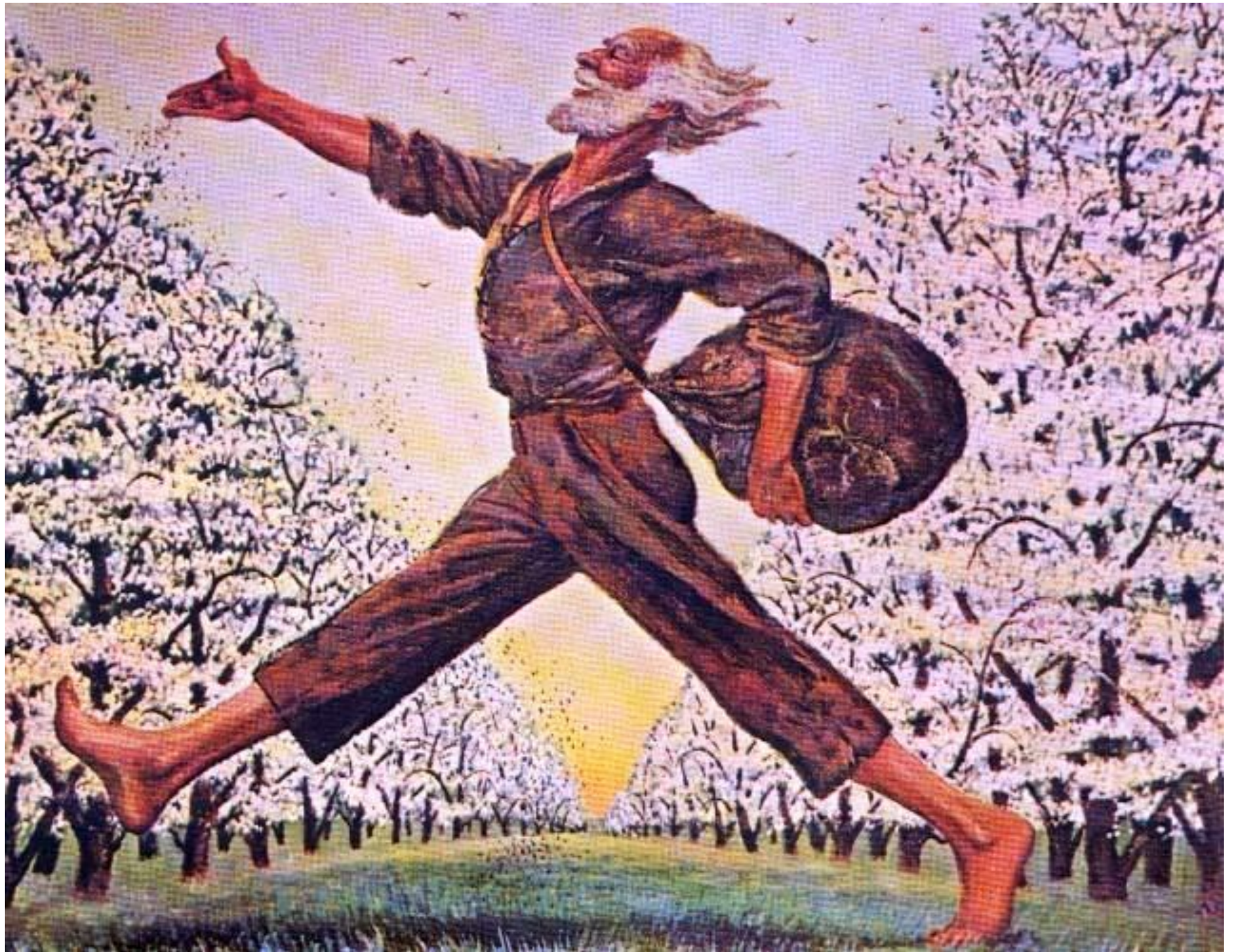
